### Age Divisions

- Sponsorship must be declared upon entry, the most suitable age category will be determined by event organisers in consultation with riders

## Event Formats

Each competition will be held in the similar format; run length may vary depending on entrant numbers.

- Each rider will receive a minimum of two 45 second runs
- The points from both runs will be added together
- The time starts on the rider's first trick
- Riders will be given a first trick rebate on their second run
- No points can be scored after the last trick.

## Conditions of Entry

- All competitors must wear helmets whilst competing (helmets provided)
- All entrants under 18 must have a signed parental competition form to enter
- Management reserves the right to refuse entry
- Entrants under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be refused entry
- Management reserves the right to move competitors into higher or lower age divisions and / or to refuse entry

## Sportsmanship

All competitors should demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times.

- Follow the direction of the event staff.
- Respect all competitors, league officials, judges and spectators.

## Rain date

All SEL events are held on Saturdays, If it rains the event will be automatically rescheduled for the following Sunday

## Competitors' code of conduct

- Competitors shall not use abusive or disrespectful language.
- Competitors shall not taunt or humiliate any other participant.
- Competitors shall not abuse, mistreat or mishandle any event equipment or property (e.g., throwing helmets or boards)

## How the competitions are judged

As a general rule, it is important to note that these 8 basic principles of skate / BMX competition judging will be used:

1. All contestants will be judged on the amount of tricks they land and their quality.
2. The greater the technical difficulty, the greater the score.
3. Contestants will be marked down if they continue to do the same tricks.
4. Tricks done after the time don't count. If you want one more shot - that's fine - it won't be tallied towards your score.
5. All Judges have been skating or riding for a long time. They only make decisions based on their professional opinion. If you disagree with a decision or competition outcome please don't take it personally.
6. The points system is only there as a guide; the final decision is for the judges to discuss and make based on event and run factors.
7. If you have a question you must ask the head judge. Please don't disturb judges during the heats.
8. Please remember the aim at these events is to get together, have roll and celebrate your talents. If you want to truly be the best you have to practice!
